The Talara Swimming Carnival is not too far away. A warm welcome is extended to you to attend our annual college swimming carnival to support and encourage your child.

- Where:** Caloundra Aquatic Centre
- When:** Tuesday 7 December 2021
- Travel:** All students will travel to and from the venue by bus
- Times:** 9:20am - Years 3 and 4                      12:20pm - Years 5 and 6
- What to bring:** Swimming costume, hat, rash shirt, towel, swimming cap, goggles, packed lunch and water bottle. Students are to apply their own sunscreen prior to school and at the pool.
- What to wear:** Sports uniform to and from school - swimwear to the pool.

The 50 metre pool will be undivided with the events of the **50m Championship Races** and the **House Novelty Competitions** running alternatively over the two sessions.

The competitors for the 50m Championship Races have been generated from trial times taken during Talara Primary College's instructional swimming lessons by John Wallace and Little Mountain swimming coaches. Each race will be composed of the eight (8) fastest swimmers of each particular stroke in their age group. These races will not only determine the Age Level Champion but also the Talara Swimming Team in 2022. In these races, students may compete without their rash shirt but must put on their sports shirt or rash shirt back on at the race's conclusion.

The novelty competitions are all completed in teams of six (6) in their sporting houses. They have all been designed for maximum involvement by all students, regardless of swimming ability. Points will be generated from final places to determine the winner of the Talara Primary College Swimming Sporting House for 2021.

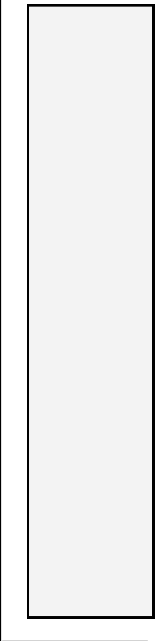
To support the team culture of the carnival, all students are to remain with their sporting houses unless otherwise directed by staff.

I am looking forward to an awesome carnival experience for our swimming students.

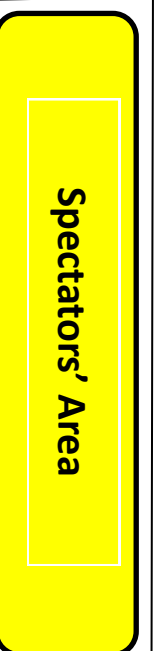

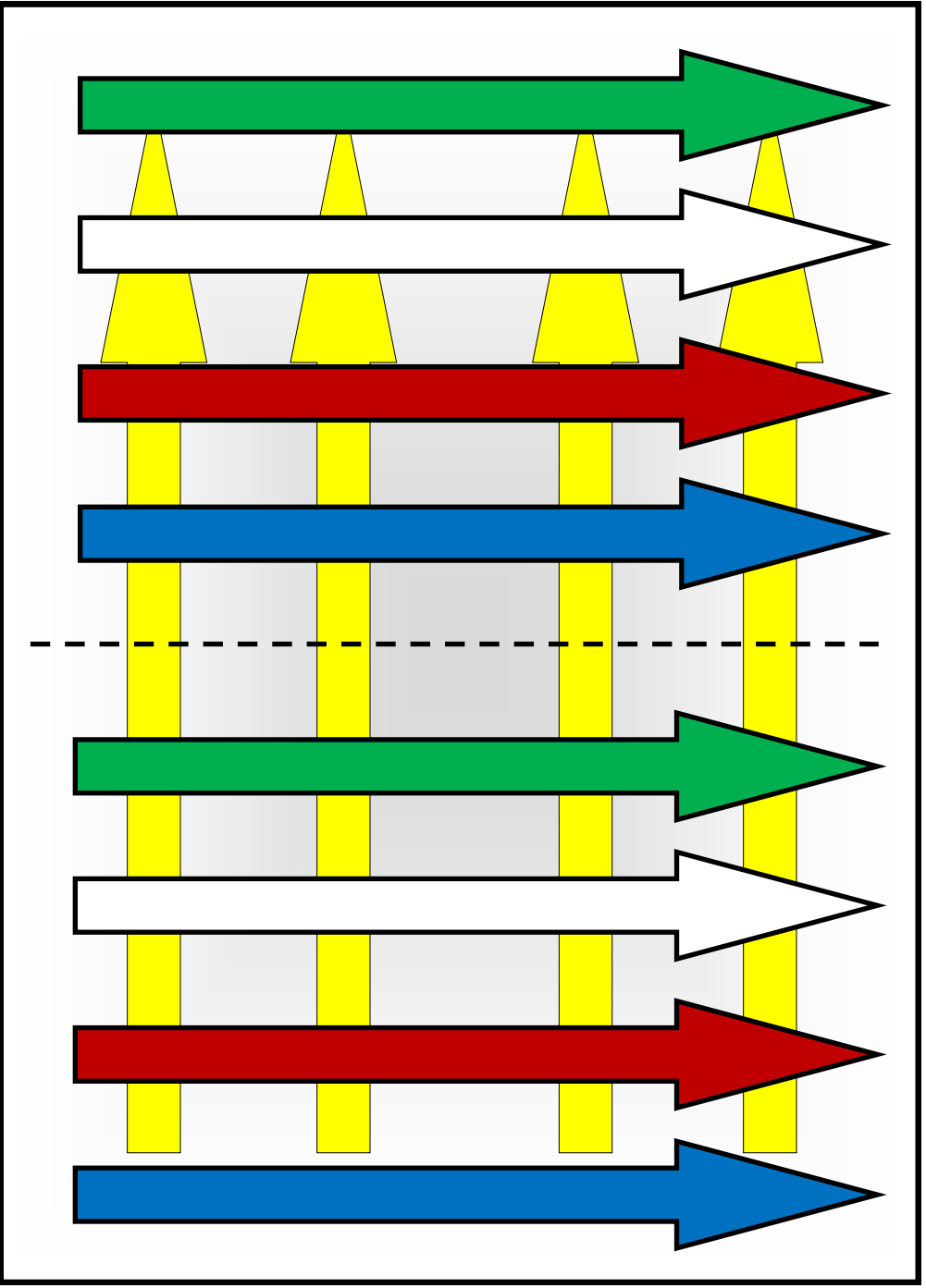

Spectators' Area

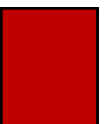
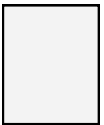
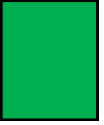


Time Keeping Area for Championship Races
