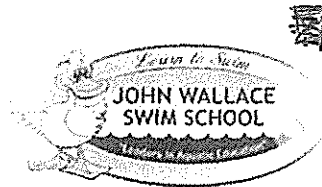


AQUATICS PROGRAM 2021

Dear Parents & Carers

As part of our Physical Education Curriculum, students at Talara Primary College will attend a swimming program hosted by the John Wallace Swimming School and Little Mountain Aquatic Centre instructors at the Caloundra Aquatic Centre for Years P-2 or the Currimundi Recreational Centre Pool for Years 3-4 and Little Mountain Aquatic Centre Years 5-6.

Prep students will participate in 8 lessons as part of Foundation Level—Introduction to swimming.

Year 1 and Year 2 will participate in 4 lessons. Year 3-6 will participate in 8 lessons.

Swimming lessons will commence Week 2 of Term 4 for all Year levels except Year 2. They will commence in Week 6.

Swimming lessons for Prep-Year 2 will be held on Fridays. Year 3 to 6 will be held on Mondays.

Students will travel to and from each of the swimming venues on Glasshouse Country Coaches.

All students require a sun shirt, thongs, towel, goggles (optional) and swim cap (optional).

Sunscreen should be applied before leaving home.

A strict NO SUNSHIRT = NO SWIM policy will apply.

Please note that administration, teachers and pool management reserve the right to exclude any child from swimming on the grounds of injury, illness, behaviour and/or safety.

The Talara Swimming Program will culminate in week 10 with a Year 3 to 6 Swimming Carnival on Tuesday 7th December at the Caloundra Aquatic Centre. The **Year 3 and 4 cohorts** will compete in the **morning session** (9:30 - 11:45) whilst the **Year 5 and 6 cohorts** will compete in the **afternoon session** (12:00 - 2:15).

Additional to the swimming program outlined above, Year 6 students will engage in a Surf Awareness Program at Kings Beach in Week 10 on Monday 6th, Tuesday 7th and Thursday 9th December. The program is lead by qualified Australian Surf Lifesaving Lifeguards and incorporates essential surf skills, resuscitation and first aid. In addition to the compulsory swimming attire, students will require their school hats. Students will travel to and from Kings Beach on Glasshouse Country Coaches. Students must complete their instructional swimming component to participate in the surf skills component.

If for any reason a student is unable to attend a particular swimming lesson, a **written note must be sent** to the child's class teacher. ALL students are encouraged to participate. Students not participating will remain at school.

Please be advised that costings are reduced due to a subsidy grant from the state government.

Please turn over for the costings breakdown per year level.

Please note that refunds will only be generated if 2 or greater lessons are missed through illness or injury.

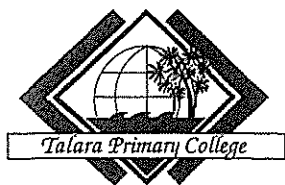

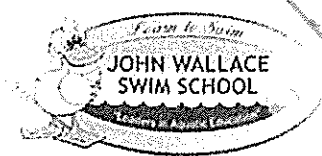
