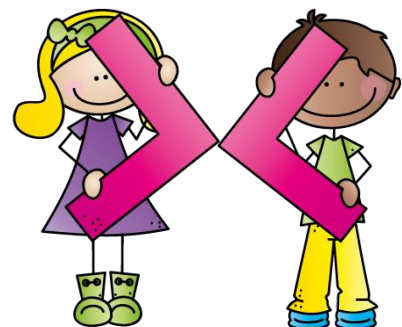
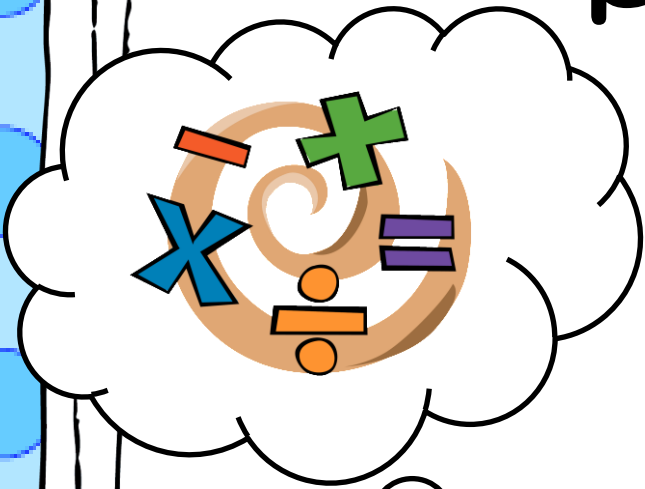


# Using Numbers or Symbols

Can using  
numbers or  
symbols make  
problem  
solving faster  
and easier?



Sometimes using numbers and symbols helps us to solve the problem in a faster, easier way.

**The Problem:** Six boys at the skate park had two skateboards each and three girls had one skateboard each. If every skateboard had four wheels, how many wheels were there altogether?



**Step One:** Write a number sentence

$$6 \times 2 \times 4 + 3 \times 1 \times 4$$

**Step Two:** Solve using mathematical conventions

$$6 \times 2 \times 4 + 3 \times 1 \times 4$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 48 \quad + \quad 12 \\ = \quad 60 \text{ wheels} \end{array}$$
