We understand choosing the right device for your student is difficult so we have worked with our feeder high schools to create the minimum recommended specifications designed to ensure the device will work well within school environments now and into high school.

*Please do not purchase a device unless you are sure it meets the specifications outlined below.*

## BYOx Process

1. Acquire Device (must meet minimum specifications).
2. Read, complete and return the Student BYOx Charter and ICT Acceptable Use Agreements.
3. Set up your device for school by visiting our school website [HERE](#)
4. Bring device to school, fully charged in W1&2 or as directed by your teacher.
5. Bring your updated and fully charged device to school daily for use in class and learning programs.

- **Do not buy Microsoft Office!** This is supplied for free to students and their families.
- There is no requirement to purchase additional antivirus software. Windows has an antivirus built in called Windows Defender. Other antivirus software may not run alongside our school network.
